NOTICE OF INQUIRY

TAKE NOTICE that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (the "Association"), will meet at Suite 200, 4010 Regent Street, in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia on **Wednesday the 16th day of February, 2011**, at the hour of 9:30 in the forenoon for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegation herein pursuant to the *Engineers and Geoscientists Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 116, as amended (the "**Act**").

AND TAKE NOTICE that the allegation against you is that contrary to the **Act**, you have demonstrated unprofessional conduct, in that, you have failed to provide the Investigation Committee or subcommittee conducting the investigation with information and records in your possession or have failed to answer, within a reasonable time, an inquiry by the Investigation Committee or subcommittee as requested in the Association's letter to you dated April 9, 2010.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that you, Orlando Gutierrez, P.Eng., have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegation.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Inquiry upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegation, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
